DECEMBER 1 Long: Genesis 1 **Short**: Gen.1:1–5, 26–31 Creation begins with God speaking light into darkness. Christ, the eternal Word, enters the world as the true Light, bringing new life and restoration.

Song: This Is My Father's World

DECEMBER 2

Long: Genesis 2

Short: Gen. 2:4–9, 15–25 God places humanity in a garden of life and fellowship. Jesus restores what was lost in the fall, bringing communion with God and true life.

Song: O Come, All Ye Faithful

DECEMBER 3

Long: Genesis 3

Short: Gen. 3:1–15

Humanity's rebellion introduces sin and death, but God promises a serpentcrushing offspring. Jesus fulfills this promise, defeating sin and restoring hope.

Song: Hark! The Herald **Angels Sing**

DECEMBER 4

Long: Genesis 4

Short: Genesis 4:1–10 Cain and Abel reveal the spread of sin and the cry of innocent blood. Christ's sacrifice speaks mercy, not vengeance, establishing a new humanity marked by grace.

Long: Gen. 8:20-9:17

Short: Gen. 9:8–17

God makes a covenant of mercy with Noah, promising to preserve the world despite human sin. The rainbow reminds us of His faithfulness. pointing forward to Christ, who brings lasting peace to

> creation. **Song:** Joy to the World

DECEMBER 6

Long: Gen. 12:1–9

Short: Gen. 12:1–3

God promises Abraham that through his offspring all nations will be blessed. Jesus is the promised descendant, bringing salvation to the world.

Song: O Holy Night

DECEMBER 7

Long: Genesis 22

Short: Gen. 22:7–14 Abraham's willingness to offer Isaac foreshadows the Father who does not withhold His only Son. Christ is the true substitute Lamb who brings salvation.

Song: Little Drummer Boy

DECEMBER 8

Long: Gen. 49:8–12; Num.

24:15-19

Short: Gen. 49:8-12

A ruler from Judah will crush God's enemies. Jesus is this promised King—the Lion of Judah and the star of salvation.

Short: Ex. 3:1–6

Short: Ex.19:3–6:

God gives Israel His covenant and law. Jesus fulfills the law perfectly and forms a new covenant people through His obedience.

The Passover lamb's blood protects God's people from judgment. Christ, the true Passover Lamb, secures redemption for all who trust Him.

Short: Isaiah 9:2, 6–7 Isaiah foretells a virgin-born Son and a divine King of endless peace. Jesus

fulfills both promises as Immanuel, God with us, the light shining in

darkness.

Song: O Come O Come Immanuel

DECEMBER 17

Long: Isaiah 11:1–10

Short: Isaiah 11:1–5

A Spirit-filled shoot from Jesse restores justice and creation. Jesus establishes this promised kingdom of righteousness, peace, and hope.

Song: Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee.

DECEMBER 18

Long: Isaiah 40:1–11

Short: Isaiah 40:3–5

God promises comfort and a forerunner to prepare the way. John the Baptist announces the arrival of Jesus, the Shepherd who gathers His

people.

DECEMBER 19

Long: Isaiah 53

Short: Isaiah 53:4–6

The suffering servant bears the sins of many. Jesus fulfills this prophecy on the cross, taking the punishment, we

deserve.

Long: Isaiah 61:1–11

Short: Isaiah 61:1–3

The anointed Servant brings good news, healing, and freedom. Jesus applies this prophecy to Himself, revealing His mission to restore the broken.

Long: Jerem. 31:31–34; Ezek. 36:22–

32

Short: Jeremiah 31:31–34 God promises a new covenant of forgiveness and renewed hearts. Jesus inaugurates this covenant through His

DECEMBER 22

Long: Ezekiel 34

Short: Ezekiel 34:11–16

God promises to shepherd His scattered flock. Jesus is the Good Shepherd who seeks, restores, and protects His people.

Long: Mal. 3:1–4; Micah 5:2–5

Short: Micah 5:2

God promises a messenger and a ruler from Bethlehem. John the Baptist prepares the way, and Jesus fulfills the promise as the Shepherd-King.

Short: Luke 1:30–33

Short: Luke 2:8–14

Short: Matthew 5:1–12

Jesus teaches the way of the kingdom, revealing blessings for the humble, merciful, and pure in heart. He fulfills the law and calls us to live in His kingdom.

Long: Mark 4:35–5:20

Short: Mark 4:39–41

Jesus calms the storm and frees people from demonic powers. His authority brings peace, restoration, and hope to a broken world.

Short: John 13:3–17

Jesus washes His disciples' feet, showing humility and love. His servant-heart prepares His followers for life in His kingdom.

On the cross, Jesus bears our sin and completes the Father's work. His death secures forgiveness and opens the way to God.
